2 ABOUT THE GE SCAN TO COOK INITIATIVE

GE Appliances has legacy of leading innovation in the kitchen. Half of all US homes own a GE appliance. Now with the introduction of WiFi capability, cooking is taking another innovative turn. GE Appliances is taking the guesswork out of preparation of meals with our precision cooking technology.

A consumer can now simply scan the UPC of a packaged food item, and the instructions will be sent to the cooking appliance of their choice. No longer do they have to worry about temperature, mode, or time. The appliance knows how to prepare the item whether they are preparing the item in the oven, microwave or another supported cooking device.

In order to enable this innovation GE Appliances is requesting our suppliers and manufacturing partners to share current preparation cooking instructions that are on the package. GE Appliances will take care of the rest, by converting those instructions into digital cook steps that can be delivered directly to the appliance. The consumer gets the benefit of one-step preparation, and you get the peace of mind of knowing the item was prepared as intended.

Example products that can be prepared with GE Appliance's Scan to Cook technology:

Cooking Technology Required	Examples of Compatible Scan to Cook Items
Ovens\Toast Ovens	Pizzas (fresh/frozen), individual and family size lasagna's and casseroles, frozen snacks, canned cookies/biscuits, frozen sides (garlic bread, taco shells), breakfast (sandwiches, waffles, pastry)
Cooktops	Items prepared in a skillet/pan such as sauces, soups, vegetables, egg products, rice, macaroni & cheese, pasta/ravioli, popcorn, hot drinks (cocoa)
Microwaves	Popcorn, individual and family size frozen meals, snacks, vegetable steamer bags, chocolate, caramel, butter, frozen sides, macaroni & cheese, breakfast (sandwiches, sausage, pastry)
Sous Vide	Sauces

3 STEPS TO BEGIN SYNC'G YOUR DATA WITH GE APPLIANCES

1. Have your accurate item data loaded into your home data pool and ensure it is ready for publication
 - a. Contact your data pool for any education you might require to complete this step
2. Review attribute requirements in Section 4 of this document to ensure you can meet our requirements
 - a. 1WorldSync Item Management customers can leverage the GE Appliances Playlist
 - i. For instruction on how to apply a Playlist, review the Enhanced UI Item Management Essentials Quick Sheets located on the Item Management Solution Center / Education & Training tab / Essential Topics area / Item Management folder
3. Fill out the Trading Partner Form on the GE Appliances Landing Page:
 - a. <https://www.1worldsync.com/community/customers/geappliances>
4. GE Appliances will create a subscription at the Information Provider GLN + Target Market = U.S. level
5. GE Appliances will send an email to the Supplier's primary data synchronization contact when they are ready for the first publications
6. Publish items
 - a. Send all items as Initial Load
 - b. GE Appliances is looking for Food items only: dry goods, frozen foods, canned goods, etc...anything that is traditionally cooked in a cooking appliance such as an oven, cooktop, toaster item, etc.
7. GE Appliances will provide feedback on publications using the following method:
 - a. RECEIVED CICs will be returned upon receipt of publication
8. Continue to send changes and corrections for all items
