2 STEPS TO BEGIN SYNCING YOUR DATA WITH FLORIDA FOOD SERVICE, INC.

2.1 Implementation Steps

1. Review the attribute requirements in Section 3 of this document to ensure you can meet the minimum attribute requirements. Please also note the below:
 - Florida Food Service requires all suppliers to populate "Does Trade Item Carry USDA Child Nutrition Label?"
 - Florida Food Service requires any suppliers that have Master Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) information for any of your products, to provide that information to Florida Food Services, Inc.
2. Complete the Trading Partner Form found on the Florida Food Service, Inc. Data Synchronization Landing page at <https://www.1worldsync.com/community/customers/florida-food-service-inc/>. This will enable Florida Food Service to create a subscription based on the Information Provider GLN submitted.
3. Have your accurate item data loaded into your GDSN certified data pool and ensure it is ready for publication in Production.
 - Contact your data pool for any education you might require to complete this step.
1. Florida Food Service will notify the primary data synchronization contact provided on the Trading Partner Form via email when a subscription for your GLN has been created and they are ready to accept your item publications.

2.2 Publication Steps

1. Publish all items to the Florida Food Service GLN **0866525000303** as **Initial Load**
 - Florida Food Service asks that you publish as many items from your catalogue as possible.
 - Only active items will be synchronized, however, having your additional product information allows our buyers to see those items and select them for future purchases!
 - Please include images and marketing information as these attributes will help us sell your product.
 - If your products are published in a hierarchy, please publish from the highest level down.
2. Florida Food Service will use the following Catalogue Item Confirmation (CIC) messages:
 - A CIC of 'RECEIVED' will be sent when a publication is received
 - If you receive a "REVIEW" or "REJECTED" status, please investigate and correct the item for republication based on the feedback in the CIC message

- A CIC with the state of "SYNCHRONIZED" will be sent after Florida Food Services' successfully receives, updates and validates supplier data
3. Suppliers should continue to send changes and corrections for all items synchronized with Florida Food Service.

2.3 Catalog Item Confirmations (CIC's)

CIC Messages:

RECEIVED: Product has been received and has passed GDSN validations. This response will typically be sent within a few hours after receiving the publication.

REVIEW: Product does not pass GDSN validations or product has failed the FFS audit process and therefore has data discrepancies to be reviewed and addressed. Reason for Review status will be transmitted in CIC999. This response may follow a Received message and may take several days to resolve.

SYNCHRONIZED: Product has been fully accepted and loaded into FFS' internal system and will be updated as revisions occur. This response will be sent after all validations and audits have been successfully completed.

REJECTED: FFS no longer wants to sync this item to their internal system or item has been de-listed by FFS.

3 ATTRIBUTE REQUIREMENTS
